**National Productivity Investment Fund: Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority bid recommendations**

I am pleased to confirm that the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority has approved and prioritised the bids from its constituent LHAs as follows:

1. A47 Junction 18 Improvements – Peterborough City Council
2. March Junctions - Cambridgeshire County Council
3. Wisbech Development Access Improvements – Cambridgeshire County Council
4. A605 Whittlesey Access Phase 2 - Stanground Access – Peterborough City Council

The Combined Authority Board endorsed the bids and ranking at its meeting on 28 June 2017, noting the critical contribution they will make to boosting productivity, transport and housing. If the bids are successful in securing funding, they will collectively:

- Support the delivery of approximately 7,000 new homes – identified in local plans;
- Support the delivery of approximately 3,000 new jobs – also identified in local plans;
- and
- Address traffic congestion at recognised bottlenecks.
