CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL PERMIT SCHEME UNDERTAKING:

This undertaking is made in consideration of section 37(9) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and regulations 29 and 32 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 (as amended) (“the regulations”).

I certify on behalf of Cambridgeshire County Council that the proposed fees payable under the Cambridgeshire County Permit Scheme have been calculated in accordance with the Department for Transport Permit Fees Guidance (dated July 2008) (“the guidance”). To the best of my knowledge and belief, the Permit Scheme is compliant with the guidance and with regulations 29 and 32 of the regulations and the income from the proposed fees will not exceed the prescribed costs of operating the Permit Scheme.

Cambridgeshire County Council undertakes to identify and evaluate the sums paid by way of fees and the prescribed costs of operating the scheme. The evaluation shall take place within 12 months of the coming into force date of the permit scheme and thereafter on an annual basis. Following each evaluation, if fee income has exceeded the prescribed costs, Cambridgeshire County Council undertakes to make the necessary adjustments to fee levels for the subsequent years in order to comply with the regulations as amended.
