

Cambridgeshire Weight Restrictions POI for TomTom

The zip file contains Points of Interest (POI) files with details of all of the weight restrictions within the administrative area of Cambridgeshire County.

There are two main types:

Weak Bridges - Vehicles above the Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight are prohibited (except emergency vehicles and some PSVs).

General - Vehicles above the MGWV are prohibited except for access (loading etc.) within the weight restricted zone.

These are further categorized by MGWV (three tonne, seven point five tonne etc.).

You can choose to load all files or just those that apply to your vehicle. If you drive a 7.5 tonne vehicle you only need to load the three tonne bridge files.

You need to load two files for each category of weight restriction, an .OV2 and a .BMP.

Installation:

1. Save the WRTomTom.exe file to a new folder on your computer
2. Double click on it to open it
3. Extract all files
4. Select the files you want and copy them
5. Connect your TomTom to your computer and switch it on
6. Say YES if it asks if you want to connect to your computer
7. Go to your TomTom in 'My Computer'
8. Open the folder named "United Kingdom and Ireland" or "Western Europe" (depending on your machine)
9. Paste the copied files into the map folder
10. Disconnect your TomTom and start it normally
11. Select 'Change preferences' then 'Warn when near POI'
12. For each category set a distance (enough to give you time to change your route) and warning sound
13. Tick 'Warn only when POI is on route'.
